

The Great Animal Race






Quick-thinking, the rat jumped on the ox's back to help him cross the river. The diligent ox did not mind and let the rat stay on his back.






The monkey who had started the race early on had fallen behind because he spent his time jumping between trees and stones.








The playful dog was more interested in spending his time splashing about in the river, instead of running the race. After having his fun, the dog finally crossed the gate and took 11th place.




十二生肖动物赛跑








第二天,动物们整备充分去跨越天门。老鼠起得很早。但它狡猾的想成为第一个穿过天门的动物,于是

小了。因此它在原地等待着。






小老鼠灵机一动,跳上牛背,借机过河。勤奋的牛不介意,便让老鼠呆在了它的背上。


看到两个动物对彼此都很礼貌,玉皇大帝便把马排在第七位,山羊排在第八位。




那只早早出发的猴子却落在了后面因为它将时间花在了在树木和石头之间跳来跳去玩耍。






狗和猪跟在后面。但这两只动物太小了,无法过河,所以它们只好静待河水平缓下来,最后才过河去见 玉皇大帝。
